The meeting was called to order at 7:09 pm by Lisa Kusumpa, Westgate PTA President

Role Call and Attendance

Seven (7) members present, including five (5) executive committee members, one (1) teacher and the Assistant Principal

Principal's Report - Scott Walton

- Officially a Leader In Me Lighthouse school! Great example of collaboration!!
- One area that the Lighthouse audit team was most impressed with was the amount of knowledge the students had regarding their own personal goals and how to meet them - regardless of age.
- In regards to sectioning for next year, Westgate has decided to try something new. A Google form will be sent out to all parents asking a few basic questions. This will be a time to note your child's strengths, how they work well, etc. but not for specific teacher request. This form will be sent out after conferences take place.
- The 5th graders will be taking the Illinois Science Assessment on Monday, March 11th. The test lasts approximately 60 minutes. Not all areas on the test have been necessarily covered in class as of yet and do not want students to feel concerned.
- The Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR) is the replacement for PARCC. Testing will take place from April 2nd through April 12th. There are two English Language Arts tests (which run approx. 75 to 90 minutes in length) and three Math tests (which run approx. 60 minutes in length). In regards to student refusals, the school's rating on Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) can be impacted.
- After the IAR is administered, MAP testing will still take place and will be scheduled in April as well.
- Westgate teacher/parent conferences will be taking place on 3/21 and 3/22.

Teacher's Report - Nicolle Mazzola

- Teachers are working hard to prepare for conferences and to make them meaningful for both the parents and students. Wherever possible, teachers plan to have students participate and set and discuss goals.
